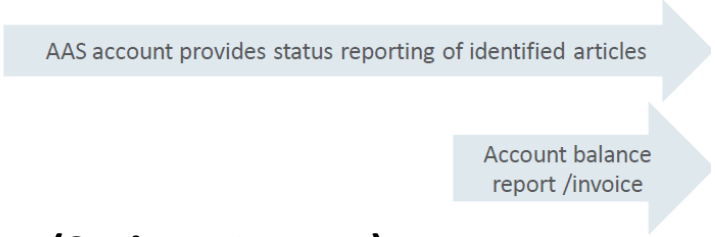
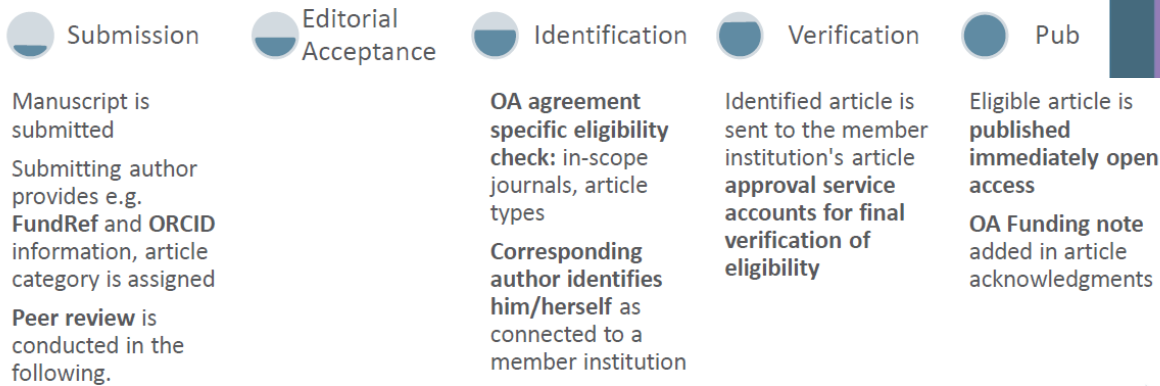

# 2. Choose OpenAccess

## Your open access option

OA option – the author can either:

- choose to order open access and the costs are covered by the institution (DEAL)
- or choose to publish traditionally non open access → **Non-OA is not recommended as this leads to extra costs**

### Publish your article open access

#### Choose „Yes: I want to publish my article with open access...“

Confirm your article will be published open access (Open Choice fees covered under a Springer Nature agreement with your institution). By publishing open access, Open Choice enables access by anyone with an internet connection, immediately on publication. Benefits to you as an author include:

- Higher visibility and greater impact: In Springer hybrid journals, open access articles are accessed 4 times more often on average, and cited 1.6 more times on average.
- Easy compliance with mandates: Many funders require open access, and some take compliance into account when assessing future grant applications.
- The copyright remains with you: Most Open Choice articles are published under the liberal Creative Commons Attribution 4.0 International (CC BY) license.
- If you do not opt to publish your article open access you will also be required to transfer the copyright of your article

Or you choose to publish traditionally, non-open access and transfer your copyright to Springer Nature. Please note that this can't be changed later.
